tuiuiú, 2017 / intervention on public space in collaboration with *sem título s.d.* curatorial collective, são paulo / handpainted flags inspired on modernist artist athos bulcão ´s tiles fixed on parliament and other federal government buildings while in the high military dictatorship period in brazil / around 300 flags were installed inline among mario de andrade public library + dom josé gaspar square + aber (brazilian association of binding and restoration) and shared for free with pedestrian public. the intervention were not negotiated with local military police officers.





there were about fifty homeless people living in the square, but we did not want to go on sort of assistentialist art, neither falling into escapist aesthetics to deny the reality of that place. We wanted to get out of that dichotomy and try other relationships, even though we know that the ethic and aesthetic limits of art are always very tenuous.
